Dear Parent/Carer

Re: Year 11 Transition Work

I wanted to write to you personally to let you know how we have been supporting your child during this time of partial school closure and to outline the systems we have put in place to support your child's transition to further education.

You may already be aware that most pupils are now studying remotely using the Microsoft Teams programme and will continue to do so until it is safe for schools to reopen. Our A Level teachers here at sixth form have been working hard to ensure that your child is fully prepared for further study at college and we have put together a programme of study to support this transition.

As of Monday 20th April, your child has been able to access a whole range of subject-specific work, which they can complete and submit for feedback from teachers. We have encouraged all pupils to complete this work and receive feedback from teachers as it will allow them the best possible start to their sixth form experience in September. This work was initially designed for Year 11 pupils who are staying with us to study at sixth form, but we have now made it available for all pupils to access, regardless of their destination of choice.

In addition, our sixth form learning mentor is also regularly sharing enrichment activities via a weekly newsletter. These activities and updates offer a range of things that your child can be doing at home, such as wider reading and interesting documentaries.

As a final note, given the popularity of our smaller class sizes and the likelihood of continued social distancing measures until a vaccine is available, we have decided to re-open applications for sixth form to internal applicants only. With a maximum class size of 10 students, we are wholly confident that when schools do reopen, we will continue to provide a safe, secure environment for your child. If your son/daughter did not apply to sixth form earlier in the year, or chose to study elsewhere and would now like an application form, they should contact me either by the main school telephone number or by emailing admin@moorpark.mp with the reference 'sixth form application'.
