Every Wednesday afternoon you will attend your timetabled enrichment session. Wednesday enrichment covers a range of topics and are the session are designed to:

# Year 12 Work

Every July, All Year 1 students will attend a week of work experience. It is your responsibility to find and source your own placement using the torms and documents we will give you. Obviously, if you are struggling to find something, sixth form tutors and learning mentors will be able to support you.

How does work experience work?

You will find your own placement and get the setting agreed by sixth form staff

When you return to sixth form you will have the opportunity to reflect on your experiences and begin to think about how you can use them to work towards your future goals



You will keep a journal of your experiences across the week – things you have learned about yourself and the company

As you move into Year 13, you will be able to use your work experience as part of your university or apprenticeship applications
